The CBSE envisions a robust, vibrant and holistic school education that will engender excellence in every sphere of human endeavor.

The board is committed to providing quality education to promote intellectual, social and cultural vivacity among its learners. It works towards evolving a learning process and environment, which empowers the future citizens to become global leaders in the emerging knowledge society. The Board commits itself to providing a stress-free learning environment that will develop competent, confident and enterprising citizens who will promote harmony and peace.

This month CBSE has dedicated the Academic session 2020-21 for 'Competency Based Learning' where the focus of teaching is on the outcomes that students need to acquire. In consonance with this move towards outcome-based education, the Central Board of Secondary Education, in collaboration with Central Square Foundation, New Delhi, has developed the **Teacher Energized Resource Manuals (TERM)**, a series of Manuals for teachers of Science and Mathematics for classes VI to X. These Manuals will help the teachers in aligning their classroom transaction to build competencies.

The Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation (DDWS), Ministry of Jal Shakti which is the Nodal Department for **Swachh Bharat- Grameen** is establishing a State-of-Art Rashtriya Swachhata Kendra (RSK) at Gandhi Darshan, Rajghat, New Delhi. The RSK is being set up as an experience center, which uses modern technology to chronicle India's Swachhata journey in a hi-tech edutainment format with a mix of indoor digital and outdoor physical exhibits. The RSK has been inaugurated on 8th August, 2020. On this occasion, DDWS has launched the **Gandagi Mukh Bharat (GMB)** campaign, a special week long campaign for Swachhata was done in the month of August.
